VCGI must change its business model to be financially viable after Oct. 1, 2014.

VCGI must change its operational model to be relevant to state/academic/public future needs.

VCGI Needs to Move Forward On Effecting Both of Those Changes - Now.

What is Done In Other States

- Co-located with IT departments in: CA, CO, DC, ID, KS, KY, ME, MD, MA, MI, MN, MO, NE, NJ, NM, NC, ND, OH, OR, PA, PR, SD, TN, VA, WA, WI, and WY. A total of 27 out of 50.
- Within Other Departments: Agency of Admin, Office of Finance, State Library (DE, IN, AL, AK, MT).
- Within Transportation or Natural Resources Agencies (generally not full state focused).
- Universities (also poor state focus) (NH, MO)
- State Non-profit – VT, IN
