History



Coordinated GeoData Collection in VT

- 1988 - Office of Geographic Information Services (OGIS)
- 1994 – VT Center for Geographic Information (VCGI)
 - Town, Regional, State, and Federal
 - Policy, Standards, Guidelines
 - Began Cataloging and Distributing geodata!

History



But was it Open Data?

1994 Act 204 (10 VSA Chapter 8)

- "Assure that all VGIS data is...shared with other public-sector and private-sector data users."
- "...made available to the user in a usable format in accordance with 1 V.S.A. § 315 relating to access to public records..."

Online GeoData Distribution

- 1998 – 1st VCGI website offering data
- 2001 – 2nd VCGI website with improved data access options
 - Database driven
 - On-the-Fly clip & zip
 - Federated architecture

Many Sources of GeoData

- VCGI and Partners via VCGI website
- Directly from Federal, State, Regional, and Local government
- Many private sector sources
- Explosion of demand and innovation...location is a commodity
